We are excited to welcome customers back to the vineyard but must follow the policies set forth by the Governor's "Phase Three" plan to reopen businesses. In an effort to follow those regulations and to protect customers and staff, all persons must adhere to the following rules as a condition of staying on Bluestone Vineyard property. We will strive to create the same relaxing and welcoming atmosphere as before while creating a safe and healthy experience.

### Reservations Required

All guests are required to make a reservation and check in at the Tasting Room upon arrival. To make a reservation, call the Tasting Room at 540-828-0099. Information that guests will need to provide is:

Date and Time, Name, Phone Number, Number in your Party, Number of Children, Dogs (yes or no)

Reservation areas have been carefully mapped out to follow social distancing guidelines. All guests must practice social distancing of at least 6 feet from persons not in their party. Please be considerate of other guests and do not enter their assigned table area.

### Indoor and Patio Service

The Tasting Room is now open! Service and seating is available inside with a reservation. Indoor and outside patio seating is for adults 21+ only for social distancing reasons. Children and dogs are still more than welcome but will be seated at the upper lawn area.

### Masks, Health and Sanitation

***All visitors must properly wear face masks whenever they are away from their seating area.*** Our staff will be wearing face coverings to keep you safe as well. Guests must also practice maintaining six feet of physical distance from other groups. Bluestone will have masks for purchase of \$2.00 per mask.

Additionally, we have instituted heightened disinfection and cleaning of restrooms, seating areas, registers, and high touch areas all in accordance with CDC guidelines. Each seating area will be disinfected between each party.

You will also notice four hand sanitizing stations for your convenience. Please do not visit Bluestone while experiencing any COVID-19 symptoms including a fever, dry cough, shortness of breath, chills, headache and sore throat. If we are aware that you are, we must refuse to serve you or your party.

### On Premise Wine Sales and Policies

***We are now offering bottle sales, wine by the glass, and sampler options. Growler fills are back for offsite consumption.*** All glasses are plastic and disposable. We will continue to not offer tastings at the bar for the safety of guests and staff. For service, please enter the front entrance of the Tasting Room.

### Additional Policies

- No smoking anywhere on the property.
- No other alcohol may be brought onto Bluestone Vineyard property.
- All guests must leave by 6:00 closing time to give employees time to clean up your area.
